Frequently asked questions

Is there any change to the English language tests are you accepting during COVID-19?

Many English testing centres are currently closed due to the COVID-19 situation. However, we are accepting:

- IELTS Indicator
- TEOFL
- iBT Special Home Edition
- Duolingo English tests

Once you are able to move onshore for your studies, you may be required to submit a more recent English test that meets the minimum requirements for entry prior to you being issued with a confirmation of enrolment (COE) and student visa. Any questions related to student visas for study in Australia should be directed to the Department of Home Affairs nearer the time of your student visa application.

How will these alternative English tests affect visa applications?

You may be required to take an additional language test to qualify for a student visa. Any questions related to student visas for study in Australia should be directed to the Department of Home Affairs nearer the time of your student visa application.

What if my visa application is rejected when borders re-open?

If you start your studies online and are based offshore, you will be offered a full refund if you are unsuccessful in obtaining a visa to study in Australia after the borders reopen and you do not wish to continue your degree online.

What if I change my mind?

You will have until the census date on 9 August 2020 to decide if you wish to continue your studies. If you choose to withdraw before this date you will get a full refund on your tuition fees.

Will I get help to study online?

At Charles Sturt University, we're here to help you achieve your goals. You will benefit from the same level of exceptional, high-quality teaching you would receive if you were starting on campus. Once you've started your course, you can access interactive workshops, one-to-one web-based training and online courses to help develop your online study skills.

Am I eligible for a scholarship?

To be eligible to apply for 30% fee discount, you must be a new international student applying for the 2020 or 2021 intake at our Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst, Orange, Port Macquarie or Wagga Wagga campuses. Visit our website for more information about eligibility.

How do I apply for a scholarship?

Your eligibility for the scholarship will be considered as part of the normal course admissions process, so you don't need to do anything other than apply for your chosen course!

When do scholarship applications close?

Applications are open for July 2020 and February 2021 intakes and until further notice.
