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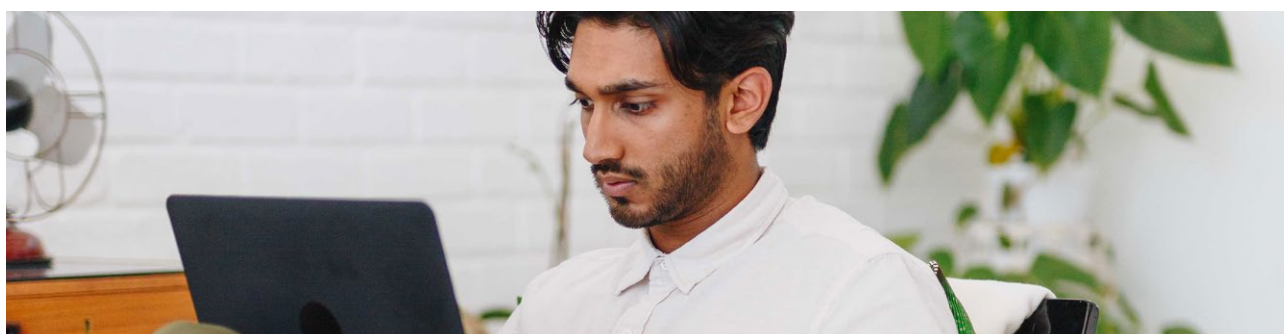

## General English Program (CRICOS #049258C)

WHAT IS THIS COURSE FOR?	COURSE DURATION:	NOTE:
Improve your English language proficiency for travel and study, or to communicate with English speakers around the world. This course helps to develop your grammar, speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills. You can start at any level, from beginner to advanced, and finish at any exit point that suits your individual needs.	2 - 50 weeks (20 hours per week)	Successful completion at the upper intermediate level will enable your direct entry to TAFE NSW courses with an IELTS 5.5 entry requirement.



## English For Academic Purposes (CRICOS #0101064)

WHAT IS THIS COURSE FOR?	COURSE DURATION:	NOTE:
This course will improve your English language proficiency and academic strategies for successful participation in academic and Higher Education courses in Australia. The course has flexible exit points so you can leave when you have achieved the level of proficiency required for your next course of study.	5 - 20 weeks (20 hours per week)	The entry requirement for this course is IELTS 5.5 or equivalent. Students who have successfully attained Upper Intermediate level (CEFR B2) at a TAFE NSW English Language Centre are admitted into the English for Academic Purposes program.



## Pathways

TAFE NSW will help you meet the English entry requirements of your chosen vocational or higher education course.



Studying English with TAFE NSW offers you guaranteed entry into any of TAFE NSW's courses offered to international students. This includes 150 vocational qualifications (certificates to advanced diplomas<sup>^</sup>) and 10 bachelor's degrees.



TAFE NSW English for Academic Purposes is accepted by several Australian higher education providers as meeting the English entry requirements for degrees on offer.
