



Charles Darwin University (CDU) Summer Semester 2020 Scholarship

The first 200 international students to accept an offer to study in CDU's Summer Semester 2020 (November intake) will be automatically awarded a 10% tuition scholarship.

Full details and conditions below:

Summer Semester 2020 Scholarship	
How to apply	No application is required. Applicants are automatically assessed after submitting their application for any undergraduate or postgraduate coursework degree.
What students will receive	The scholarship applies to an undergraduate or postgraduate coursework degrees and covers 10% of the tuition fees for the first two semesters.
Conditions	The scholarship is neither transferable for cash nor refundable and cannot be transferred to another person, semester, course or year; This scholarship is limited to the first 200 applicants who accept an offer to start in November 2020. The scholarship will be awarded until all 200 scholarship places have been filled.
Eligibility criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Applicants must apply to commence study in November 2020 only (Summer Semester 2020 intake); - Applicants must meet the University's academic and English language entry requirements for their chosen course; - Applicants must be an International student onshore or offshore paying international student fees; - Applicants must not hold another tuition fee scholarship from CDU or any other Australian or foreign sponsorship agency
Selection criteria	No application is required. All eligible applicants will receive a scholarship until the scholarship quota is filled.
Duration	The duration of the scholarship is first two semesters (maximum 40 Credit Points each semester) or when one of the following is true: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The maximum scholarship value has been exhausted; - Recipient no longer meets the ongoing eligibility of the scholarship.
Ongoing eligibility	In order to retain the scholarship, the recipient must meet all the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Continue to be an international student liable for international student fees; - Pay their portion of the tuition fees on or before the payment due date; - Maintain a passing GPA of 4.0 with no fail grade in any unit.
Successful applicants	If an application is successful, we'll notify the recipient with an email confirming the details of the scholarship.
