

2021 INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

The University of Adelaide is committed to providing ongoing certainty to international students by offering generous scholarships based on academic merit for the years 2021-2025.







University of Adelaide Global Citizens scholarships

This scholarship rewards international students commencing an undergraduate or postgraduate qualification who have received academic merit in their studies.

Scholarship value

Students will be awarded a scholarship of between 15% - 30% off the tuition fee each year of study for the minimum standard duration of the undergraduate or postgraduate degree.

Commencing an undergraduate qualification

- Year 12 overseas student with a minimum ATAR equivalent of 80 for a 15% scholarship
- Year 12 overseas student with a minimum ATAR equivalent of 90 for a 30% scholarship

Commencing a postgraduate qualification

- Minimum grade point average (GPA) of 5.0/7 or equivalent to receive a 15% scholarship
- Minimum grade point average (GPA) of 6.0/7 or equivalent to receive a 30% scholarship.

Higher Education scholarships

This scholarship is awarded to international students who demonstrate their loyalty to Australian education by completing a recognised degree or program at an Australian Higher Education (AQF) institution. International students undertaking Australian year 12 curriculum's either in Australia or overseas who have achieved academic merit in their studies are eligible for the Higher Education scholarship to be applied.

Scholarship value

Students will be awarded a scholarship of 25% off the tuition fee for each year of study for the minimum standard duration of the undergraduate or postgraduate degree.

Commencing an undergraduate qualification

Minimum ATAR score of 80 (VCE, HSC, ACT, SACE, TCE, WACE), or International Baccalaureate (IB) score of 28.

Commencing a postgraduate qualification

Successful completion of a recognised higher education program within Australia.

These scholarships are automatically awarded at time of offer to applicants who meet academic merit requirements. A small number of programs are exempted from scholarships.
